NPL AND NASHVILLE SOUNDS PARTNER FOR NEW, LIMITED EDITION LIBRARY CARD



Sounds Host "Library Day" During Home Game Sunday, July 17

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Nashville Public Library and the Nashville Sounds today unveiled a new, limited edition library card.

The card — featuring Booster, the team mascot — is free and available to new and existing patrons throughout July, as long as supplies last.

Meanwhile, the Sounds July 17 game at First Horizon Park — when the team takes on the Memphis Redbirds at 1:05 p.m. — is also "Library Day."

An NPL crew will be on site to register fans for this special card, and Library Director Kent Oliver will throw the ceremonial first pitch.

“To have a new library card with Booster on it is great. To have the chance to go and interact with fellow Sounds fans and future patrons is a great opportunity for NPL to strengthen our community ties. I’d like to thank the Nashville Sounds for their generosity and collaboration as we launch this partnership,” Oliver said.

“We’re very excited to partner with the Nashville Public Library and continue to be a pillar in the community,” said Nashville Sounds General Manager and COO, Adam English. “We hope Sounds fans and readers alike will take advantage the unique chance to have a Booster NPL card!”

How to Get a Nashville Sounds Library Card

Patrons can get their NPL library card by either [applying online](#) or visiting [any of NPL's 21 locations](#). New and existing patrons must visit an NPL location to receive their physical card.

Davidson County residents can get the card free of charge, with unrestricted access to all of NPL’s collections.

Existing cardholders can upgrade to the new design at no charge and keep their library card number.

Tennessee residents outside of Davidson County can sign up for a free library card to check out physical materials, with an option to pay \$10 annually to access NPL’s digital materials.
