The Library-produced podcast is an extension of the popular <u>NPL Means</u> <u>Business</u>, a free initiative for entrepreneurs and small business owners.

Available on Apple Podcasts, Pocket Casts, Spotify, and YouTube, Business As Usual is the latest in a roster of NPL podcasts that are finding audiences in Nashville:

<u>Overdue Adventures</u>, another recent addition, is a first-ever actual-play series starring NPL employees with a deep talent for bringing roleplaying games to life—including the magic of fairytales, ghost stories and mystery novels during this season's "Ghosts of Saltmarsh" series.

Meanwhile, guests of NPL's <u>The Spark</u> podcast on art and creativity include local creators from within and beyond the Library, including ceramists, comedians, and everyone in between.
